WHO MAY REGISTER FOR CLASSES?

- High school SENIORS with a GPA of 2.5 or above may register for two classes for a maximum of 6 credits.
- High school SENIORS with a GPA of 2.0 to 2.5 may register for one class.
- High school JUNIORS with a GPA of 2.75 or above may register for one class.
- High school Freshmen or Sophomores may be permitted to register for one class only under special circumstances with permission of the class instructor and the Director of Admissions.
- Students in elementary, junior high or middle school are encouraged to contact the Director of Admissions for information on course enrollment at UAF.

WHAT APPLICATION MATERIALS ARE NECESSARY?

- Complete this application form.
- Ask your parent or guardian and a school official (counselor or principal) to indicate consent to your enrollment by signing the appropriate spaces below.
- Have an official transcript of your high school transcript with grades earned to date sent to the UAF Office of Admissions. If you hand-carry the transcript to the Office of Admissions, it must be in an envelope sealed by the high school.
- ACT or SAT test scores must be present if you plan to enroll in a math or English class.
